Attend a Full Council or Committee Meeting

Full Council Meetings are held the second Tuesday of every month except August, at the Parish Council Centre, Church Road, Wrockwardine Wood, Telford at 7pm.

Notices of meetings are posted on the notice board outside the Parish Council Centre, on the website and a list of meetings is published in our three monthly newsletter.

Committee Meetings are mainly held when required and details are posted on the website and on the notice board.
